

7. The exported sheep shall be kept isolated in the embarkation-quarantine facilities authorized by the government authorities of Hungary as secured and guaranteed place from an animal health point of view for at least 30 days, during which the exported sheep shall be subjected to the following examinations with negative results conducted by the said authorities. The examination for Foot-and-mouth disease should be conducted at least 3 weeks after the examination in paragraph 5.
 - (1) Foot-and-mouth disease
 - a) Probang test and,
 - b) Serum neutralization test (for types A, and C) or
Agar-gel immunodiffusion test using VIA antigen.
 - (2) Brucellosis
Tube agglutination test (less than 50 IU/ml) or
Complement fixation test (less than 50% fixation at dilution 1:10), for
both *Brucella abortus* and *Brucella ovis*.
 - (3) Piroplasmosis
Complement fixation test or Microscopic examination on blood smears.
8. The exported sheep have been medicated twice with dihydrostreptomycin 25 mg/kg with an interval of 10 to 14 days during the embarkation quarantine in paragraph 7.
9. The exported sheep have to result in no signs of any animal infectious diseases through the clinical inspections regularly conducted by the government authorities of Hungary during the embarkation-quarantine period in paragraph 7.
10. All the containers, vehicles and loading places of the ship or aircraft to be used for transportation of the exported sheep have to be cleared up in advance of loading and thoroughly disinfected with chemicals approved by the government authorities of Hungary under the supervision of the said authorities.
11. The exported sheep shall be kept isolated from any other cloven-hoofed animals during the transportation period in Hungary. No cloven-hoofed animals can be permitted the mix-loading with the exported sheep at the time of shipment to Japan.
12. Feed and bedding to be used during the transportation period of the exported sheep to Japan shall originate from the same source of those used for embarkation-quarantine.
13. No additional feed and bedding have to be provided at any port of call throughout transportation of the exported sheep to Japan.

14. The government authorities of Hungary shall be responsible for issuing the inspection certificate for the exported sheep, stating the following items in detail.

- (1) Each requirement of paragraph 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 9, 10, 11 and 12.
- (2) Dates, methods and results of the examinations in paragraph 5 and 7.
- (3) Dates and volumes of medication with dihydrostreptomycin against Leptospirosis in paragraph 8.
- (4) Kind of vaccines, name of the manufacturer, manufacturing lot number and inoculation dates, if vaccines have been applied to the exported sheep.
- (5) Name and address of the premises of origin.
- (6) Embarkation-quarantine period with starting and ending dates in paragraph 7.
- (7) Name and address of the embarkation-quarantine station in paragraph 7.
